

In the second half of 2018 this fund was converted into an Australian domiciled iShares ETF, removing the need to complete U.S. tax forms known as "W-8BEN" forms.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The fund aims to provide investors with the performance of the S&P Global 1200 Consumer Staples Sector Index™, before fees and expenses. The index is designed to measure the performance of global consumer staples companies and may include large-, mid- or small-capitalisation stocks.

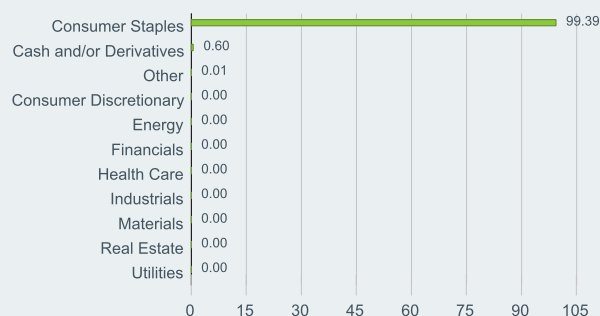

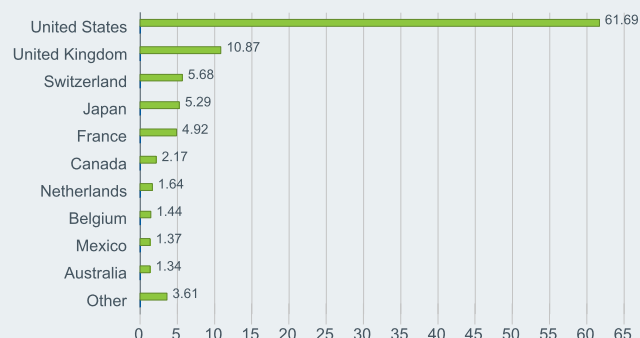
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SECTOR BREAKDOWN (%)

Negative P/E ratios are excluded from this calculation. **Price-Book (P/B) Ratio:** A fundamental measure used to determine if an investment is valued appropriately. The book value of a company is a measure of how much a company's assets are worth assuming the company's debts are paid off. Each holding's P/B is the latest closing price divided by the latest fiscal year's book value per share. Negative book values are excluded from this calculation. **Distribution Yield:** Calculated in AUD by dividing the total distributions paid over a 12 month rolling period by the Fund's closing share price as of the above date. **3.** On 21 June 2019, the Fund benchmark changed from the S&P Global 1200 Consumer Staples Sector Index to the S&P Global 1200 Consumer Staples Sector Capped Index. This is reflected in the historical benchmark performance, with returns prior to 21 June 2019 reflecting those of the S&P Global 1200 Consumer Staples Sector Index while returns from 21 June 2019 reflect those of the S&P Global 1200 Consumer Staples Sector Capped Index. Effective 21 September 2018 this listing was converted into an Australian domiciled iShares ETF. The above Inception and Listing Dates refer to those of the U.S. domiciled listing. Performance figures shown prior to this time are based on the NAV of the U.S. domiciled iShares listing converted from USD to AUD. Performance figures shown after this time are based on the NAV of the Australian domiciled iShares ETF in AUD. The restructure did not impact underlying exposures.

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SUSTAINABILITY CHARACTERISTICS

Sustainability Characteristics can help investors integrate non-financial, sustainability considerations into their investment process. ESG GLOSSARY:

MSCI ESG Fund Rating (AAA-CCC): The MSCI ESG Rating is calculated as a direct mapping of ESG Quality Scores to letter rating categories (e.g. AAA = 8.6-10). The ESG Ratings range from leader (AAA, AA), average (A, BBB, BB) to laggard (B, CCC).

MSCI ESG Quality Score - Peer Percentile: The fund's ESG Percentile compared to its Lipper peer group.

Fund Lipper Global Classification: The fund peer group as defined by the Lipper Global Classification.

Funds in Peer Group: The number of funds from the relevant Lipper Global Classification peer group that are also in ESG coverage.

MSCI ESG Quality Score (0-10): The MSCI ESG Quality Score (0 - 10) for funds is calculated using the weighted average of the ESG scores of fund holdings. MSCI rates underlying holdings according to their exposure to industry specific ESG risks and their ability to manage those risks relative to peers.

MSCI ESG % Coverage: Percentage of the fund's holdings for which the MSCI ESG ratings data is available. The MSCI ESG Fund Rating, MSCI ESG Quality Score and MSCI ESG Quality Score – Peer Percentile metrics are displayed for funds with at least 65% coverage (or 50% for bond funds and money market funds).

MSCI Weighted Average Carbon Intensity (Tons CO2E/\$M SALES): Measures a fund's exposure to carbon intensive companies. This figure represents the estimated greenhouse gas emissions per \$1 million in sales across the fund's holdings. This allows for comparisons between funds of different sizes.

MSCI Weighted Average Carbon Intensity % Coverage: Percentage of the fund's holdings for which MSCI Carbon Intensity data is available. The MSCI Weighted Average Carbon Intensity metric is displayed for funds with any coverage. Funds with low coverage may not fully represent the fund's carbon characteristics given the lack of coverage.

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
