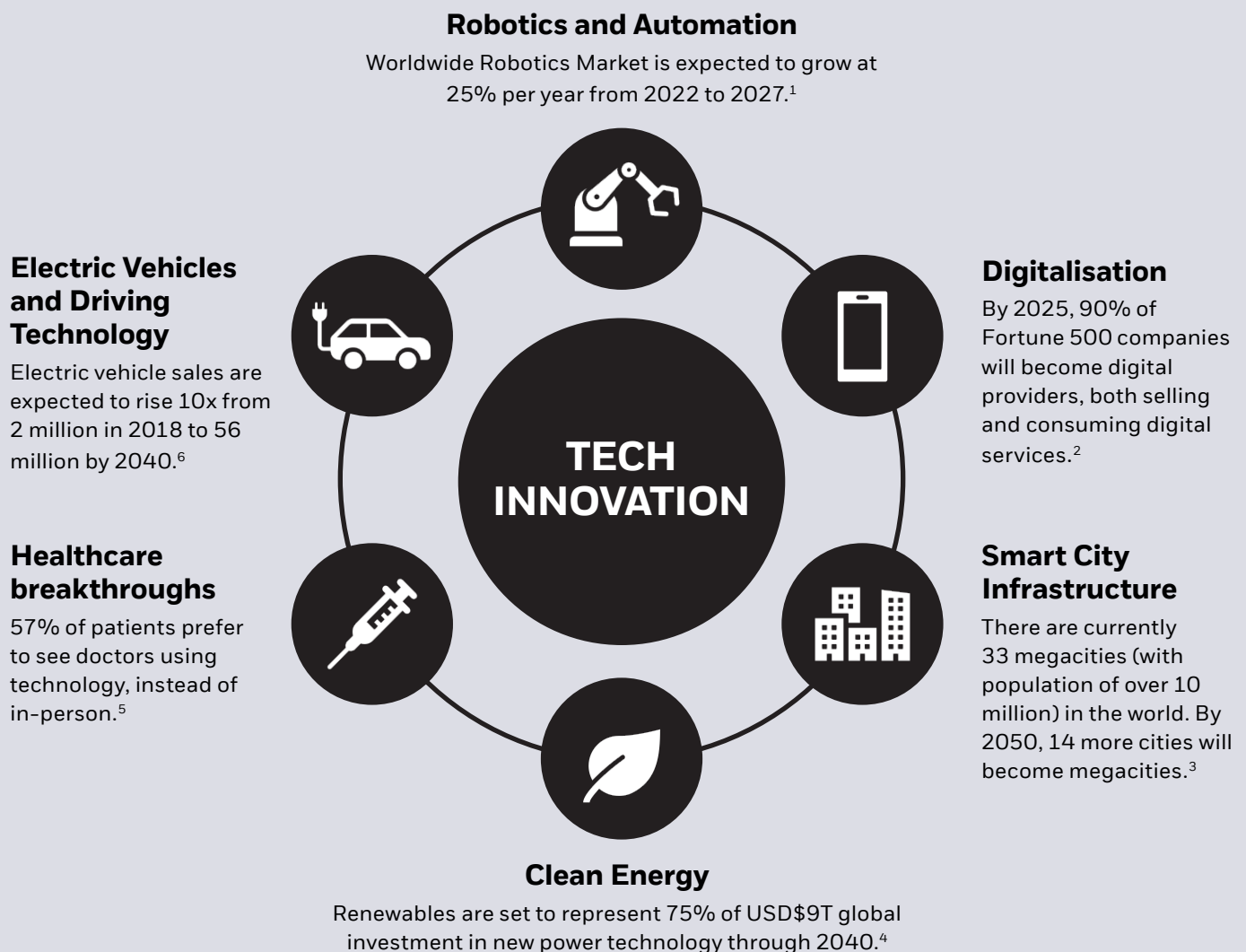

iShares Automation & Robotics UCITS ETF

Companies that are developing automation and robotics technology, with growth potential due to major structural drivers including lower development costs, evolving technology and rising cost of labour.

iShares Healthcare Innovation UCITS ETF

Portfolio focused on innovation within global healthcare services that have growth potential due to major structural drivers including shifting global demographics, social changes and the increased application of technology.

iShares Digitalisation UCITS ETF

Companies that are positively exposed to the digital services with growth potential due to the increasing prevalence and application of digital services.

iShares Electric Vehicles & Driving Technology UCITS ETF

Secular growth trend to take advantage of the irreversible shift towards electric vehicles and the development of autonomous driving.

iShares Smart City Infrastructure UCITS ETF

Takes advantage of the growth in urbanization by providing exposure to companies that are shaping the cities of tomorrow.

iShares Global Clean Energy ETF

Companies involved in clean energy production and the provision of clean energy equipment/technology while excluding companies which exceed a carbon emissions threshold.

ESG screening criteria is applied to exclude companies involved in select unsustainable businesses and practices.

4

Stock diversification and liquidity

A minimum number of stocks and an adjusted weighting scheme that balances between all-cap exposure and index replicability.

Opportunity
