BlackRock Declares Quarterly Dividend of \$1.68 on Common Stock; Laurence D. Fink to Present at the Deutsche Bank Global Financial Services Investor Conference on June 4th

New York, May 30, 2013 – BlackRock, Inc. (NYSE:BLK) today announced that its Board of Directors has declared a quarterly cash dividend of \$1.68 per share of common stock, payable June 24, 2013 to shareholders of record at the close of business on June 10, 2013.
