FUND OVERVIEW

The fund aims to achieve a return on your investment, through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets, which reflects the net total return of the MSCI Emerging Markets Index, the Fund's benchmark index ("Index").

KEY BENEFITS

1. Exposure to global developed market equity securities the return on which will be paid to the counterparties to meet the Fund's payment obligations under the terms of the unfunded total return swaps.
2. Access to large and mid-capitalisation stocks across emerging market countries.
3. This Fund is suitable for medium to long term investment, though the Fund may also be suitable for shorter term exposure to the Index.

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GLOSSARY
