FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to achieve a return on your investment, through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets, which reflects the return of the Bloomberg Euro Aggregate Bond Index, the Fund's benchmark index.
- The Fund is passively managed and aims to invest as far as possible and practicable in the fixed income (FI) securities (such as bonds) that make up the Index and comply with its credit rating requirements. If the credit ratings of the FI securities are downgraded, the Fund may continue to hold them until they cease to form part of the Index and it is practicable to sell them.
- The benchmark index measures the performance of Euro denominated bonds issued by companies and governments including government agencies, and supranationals (e.g. the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development). The bonds will, at the time of inclusion in the Index, be investment grade (i.e. meet a specified level of creditworthiness).

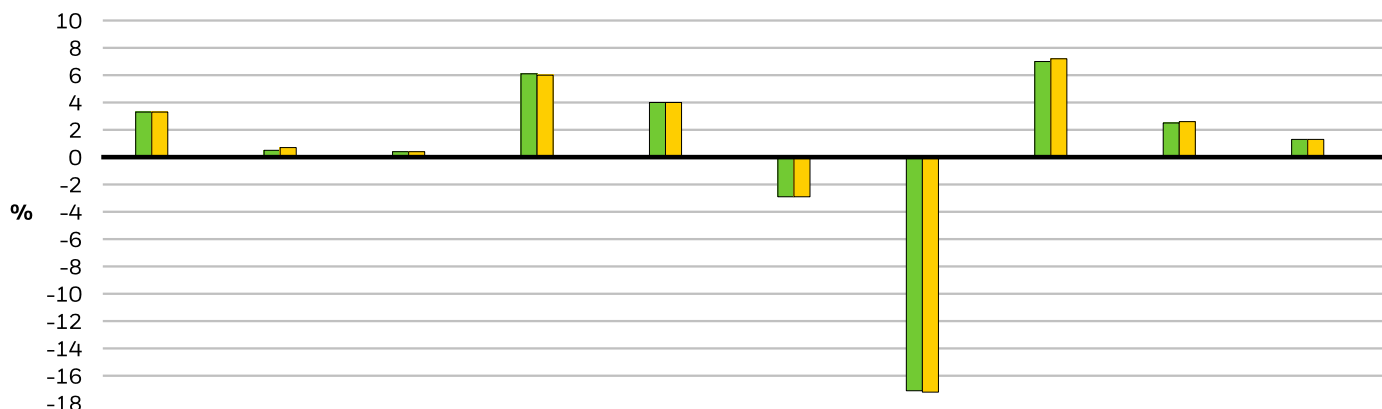
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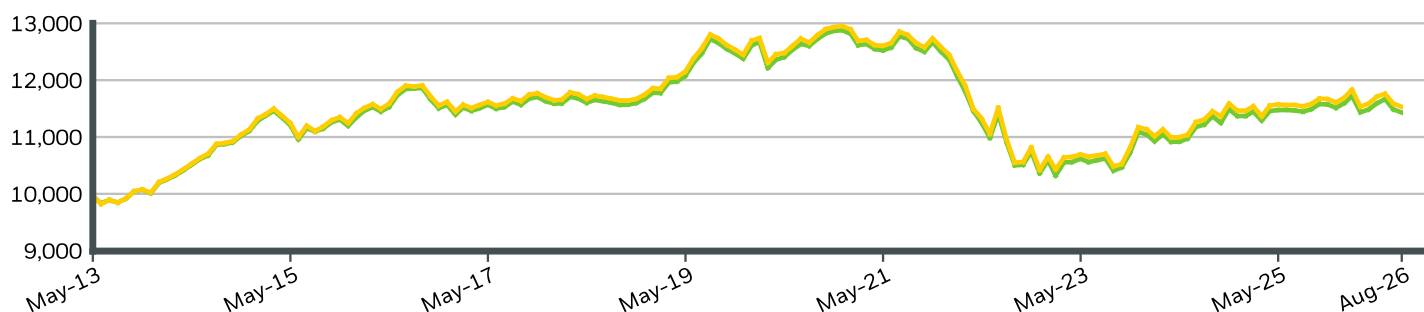

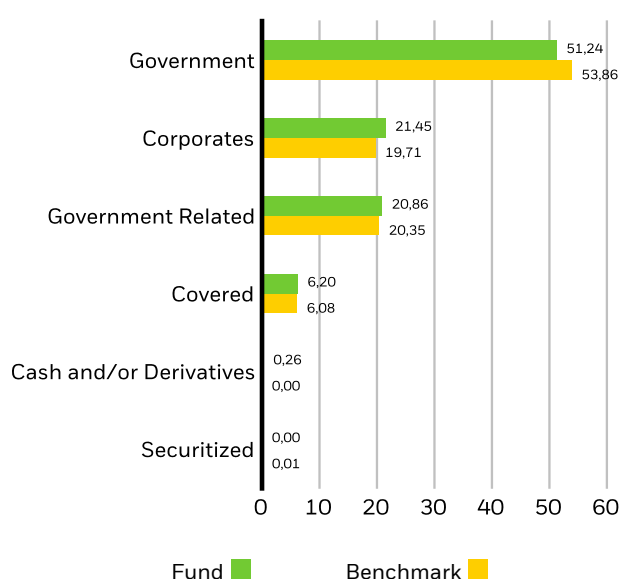

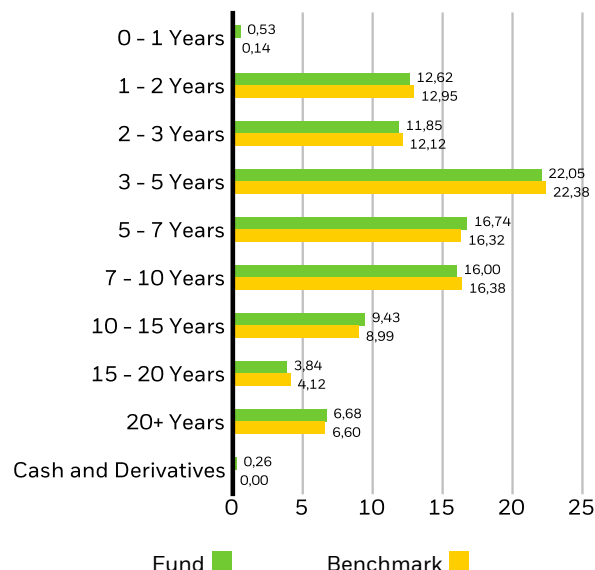

SECTOR BREAKDOWN (%)



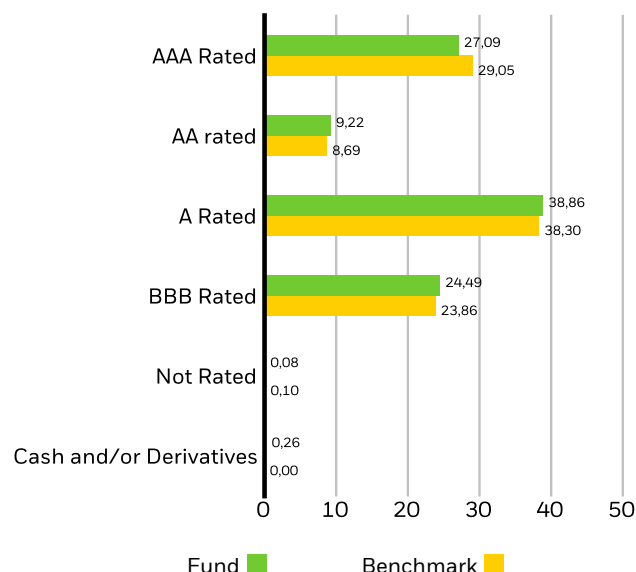

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GLOSSARY

SFDR Classification: Article 8: Products that promote environmental or social characteristics and promote good governance practices.

Article 9: Products that have sustainable investments as an objective and follow good governance practices. **Other:** Products that do not meet the criteria to be classified as Article 8 or 9.

Analyst Driven %ⁱ is the analyst input into the overall rating assignment, including direct analyst coverage and inheritance of an analyst-rated pillar

Yield to Maturity: Yield to Maturity (YTM) is the discount rate that equates the present value of bond's cash flows with its market price (including accrued interest). The fund YTM is the weighted average of fund's individual bond holding YTM's based upon Net Asset Value ('NAV'). The measure does not include fees and expenses. For callable bonds, YTM is the Yield-to-Worst.

Effective Duration: Effective duration is a measure of a fund's interest-rate sensitivity. Put simply, the longer a fund's duration, the more sensitive the fund is to shifts in interest rates. So a fund with a duration of 10 years is twice as volatile as a fund with a five-year duration.
