FUND OVERVIEW

The fund aims to achieve a return on your investment, through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets, which reflects the net total return of the S&P MidCap 400, the Fund's benchmark index (Index).

KEY BENEFITS

- 1. Exposure to the performance of 400 companies from the mid-capitalisation segment of the United States equity market, according to the index provider's size, liquidity and free float criteria.
- 2. This Fund is suitable for medium to long term investment, though the Fund may also be suitable for shorter term exposure to the Index.
- 3. The fund will enter into unfunded total return swaps in order to achieve its investment objective.

If any swap counterparty fails to provide sufficient assets as security for amounts owed to the Fund, there might be an increased counterparty risk exposure at a given time.

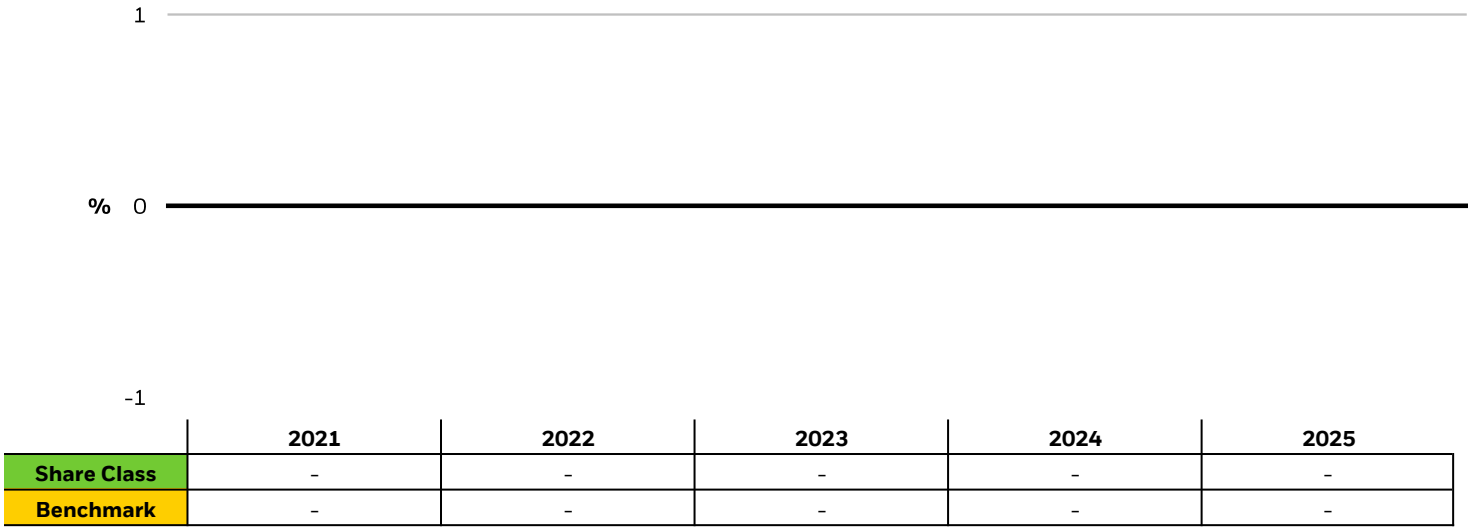

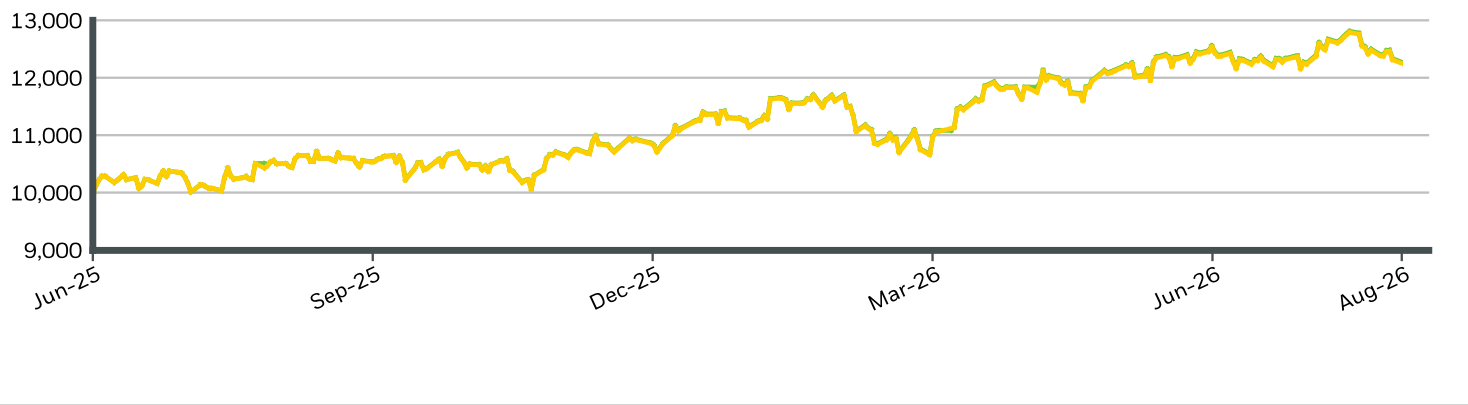
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CALENDAR YEAR PERFORMANCE

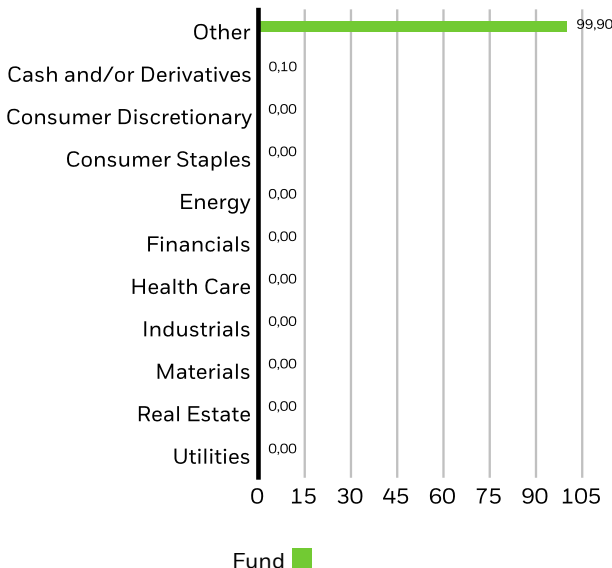

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GLOSSARY

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.
