FUND OVERVIEW

The Fund aims to reflect the price return of US large cap equities represented by the S&P 500 Index (the "Index") up to an approximate cap on positive performance of the Index (the "Upside Cap") whilst seeking to provide a level of downside protection against negative performance of the Index (the "Approximate Buffer") when shares are held from the beginning to the end of a specified 3-month outcome period (the "Outcome Period").

KEY BENEFITS

- 1. Provides exposure to US large cap equities via total return swaps and a level of downside protection against negative performance in the protected buffer performance area.
- 2. Aims to protect against approximately -5% to -20% of the Index's downside performance when shares are held from the beginning to the end of the quarter (less fees and expenses), whilst also providing the ability to capture market upside to a set cap.
- 3. Through its outcome period, the Fund has the potential to protect against equity volatility.

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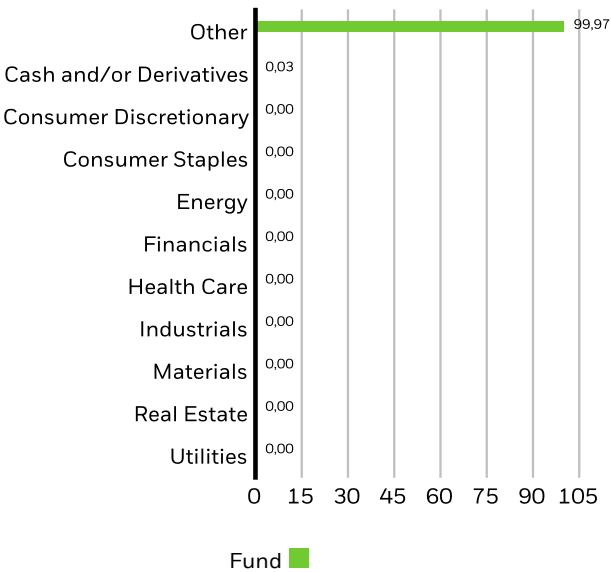

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GLOSSARY

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.

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
