FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund is a fund in a series of MyMap funds and the number allocated to the Fund does not directly relate to the level of risk or return within the Fund and is used simply to differentiate the Fund from the other MyMap branded funds in the BlackRock Investment Funds umbrella.
- The aim of the Fund is to provide, over five year periods, a return on your investment (generated through an increase in the value of the assets held by the Fund and/or income received from those assets) through an actively managed portfolio, whilst also maintaining a risk profile (i.e. an evaluation of the risks (e.g. risk of losses) associated with the portfolio) for the Fund's portfolio of 12%-15%. The Fund is actively managed and the investment manager has discretion to select the Fund's investments and is not constrained by any benchmark in this process.
- The risk profile of the Fund's portfolio, for this purpose, is measured as the volatility (i.e. the degree of fluctuation) of the Fund's returns converted into an annual rate, over a five year period. Generally, the higher the volatility, the riskier the investment.

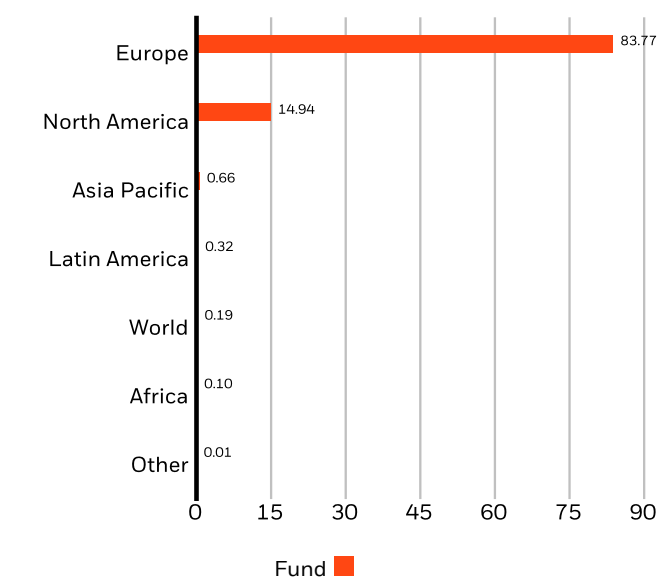

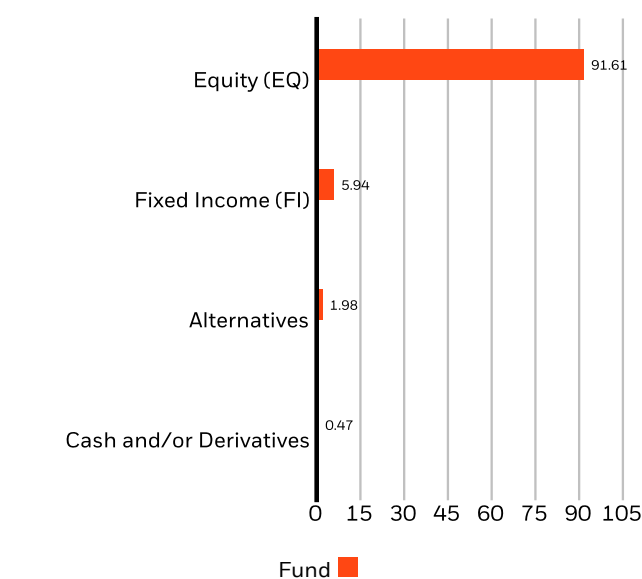

REGIONAL EXPOSURE (%)



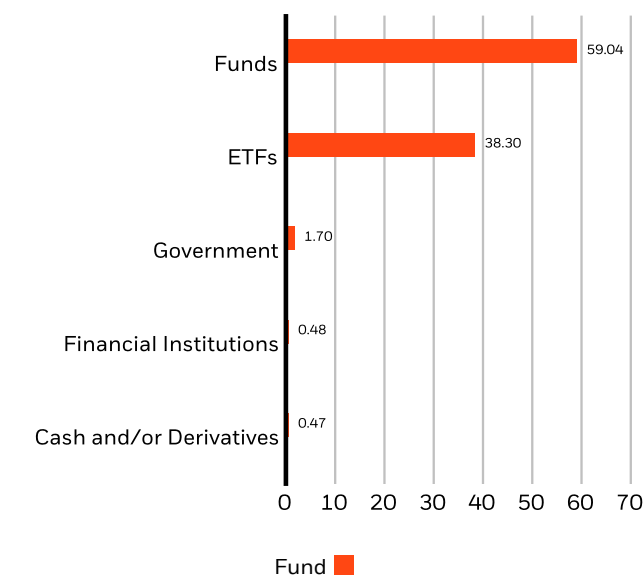

GLOSSARY

Average Market Cap: The average market capitalization of a fund's equity portfolio gives you a measure of the size of the companies in which the fund invests. Market capitalization is calculated by multiplying the number of a company's shares outstanding by its price per share.

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.

Analyst Driven %ⁱ is the analyst input into the overall rating assignment, including direct analyst coverage and inheritance of an analyst-rated pillar

Modified Duration: A measure of price sensitivity of a bond to changes in interest rates. The Modified Duration of the fund is calculated as the average of the underlying bonds' modified duration values, adjusted to take account of their relative weight (size) within the fund.

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

Data Coverage %ⁱⁱ is available input data for rating calculation at the Pillar level
