Objectives and Investment Policy

- ▶ The Fund is a sub-fund of BlackRock Authorised Contractual Scheme I taking the form of a Co-ownership Scheme (a form of investment fund constituted by contract). As a consequence of this, the Fund may be treated as tax transparent for the purpose of income and/or capital gains by relevant taxing jurisdictions. Each investor should take appropriate professional advice as to the tax treatment of their investment in the Fund. Investors in the Fund must be Eligible Investors as defined in the Fund's prospectus and must have completed all relevant documentation prior to the purchase of units in the Fund.
- ▶ The aim of the Fund is to provide exposure to companies within the FTSE Developed Asia ex Japan Index (Index) that is managed using the environmental, social and governance (ESG) criteria of the Investment Manager. These criteria are to 1) have no exposure or a reduced exposure (relative to the Index) to certain business activities for ESG related reasons, 2) reduce its overall carbon emission intensity over time relative to the Index, c) have a higher percentage (relative to the Index) of its revenues classified as green revenues; and d) maximise exposure to companies with higher BSI Intel scores (relative to the Index) (each as further described below). It aims to achieve these ESG related aims whilst also balancing the return and risk profile of the Fund to be similar to the Index. The Fund seeks to provide a gross return on your investment (generated through the value of the assets held by the Fund and/or income received from those assets) and maintain a risk profile (i.e. an evaluation of the risks (e.g. risk of losses) associated with the portfolio) that (in each case) is similar to that of the Index.
- ▶ Although the Fund aims to achieve its investment objective, there is no guarantee that this will be achieved. The Fund's capital is at risk, meaning that the Fund could suffer a decrease in value and the value of your investment could decrease as a result.
- ▶ The Fund will seek to achieve its investment objective by investing in equity securities (i.e. shares) of companies within the Index or proxies thereof (i.e. securities used as substitutes for equity securities of companies within the Index). The Fund may also invest in equity-related securities (i.e. other investments whose value is related to equities), money market instruments (debt instruments with short-term maturities), cash and other funds (including exchange traded funds). The Fund may use derivatives (i.e. investments the prices of which are based on one or more underlying assets) to help achieve its investment objective or to reduce risk or costs within the Fund's portfolio, or generate additional income.
- ▶ The Fund will apply ESG exclusionary screens to limit direct investment in companies within the Index which in the opinion of the IM have exposure to, or ties with, certain sectors, as set out in the Fund's prospectus.
- ▶ The Fund uses BlackRock Sustainable Investing Intelligence framework (BSI Intel) to identify companies eligible for investment by the Fund based on: 1) environmental considerations, 2) social issues, and 3) governance. The Fund will seek to have a higher weighted average exposure (relative to the Index) to companies with higher BSI Intel scores relative to other companies in the same or similar industries. The IM also seeks (in respect of underlying companies in which the Fund invests) to have: 1) a carbon emission intensity score that is lower than that of the Index and that reduces over time, and 2) a higher percentage of those companies' revenues classified as green revenues than the Index, as detailed in the Fund's prospectus.
- ▶ The Fund may also have indirect exposure (through, including but not limited to, derivatives and other funds) to issuers with exposures that are inconsistent with these ESG related characteristics.
- ▶ The Fund is actively managed, meaning the Investment Manager (IM) has absolute discretion to choose the Fund's investments. In doing so, the IM will refer to the Index when constructing the Fund's portfolio and also for risk management purposes to ensure that the active risk (i.e. degree of deviation from the Index) taken by the Fund remains consistent with the Fund's investment objective.
- ▶ Recommendation: This Fund may not be appropriate for short-term investment.
- ▶ Your units will be accumulating units (i.e. dividend income will be included in their value).
- ▶ Your units will be denominated in Sterling, the Fund's base currency.
- ▶ You can buy and sell your units daily. The minimum initial investment for this unit class is £10,000,000.

- ▶ The Fund is rated five due to the nature of its investments which include the risks listed below. These factors may impact the value of the Fund's investments or expose the Fund to losses.
 - Emerging markets are generally more sensitive to economic and political conditions than developed markets. Other factors include greater 'Liquidity Risk', restrictions on investment or transfer of assets, failed/delayed delivery of securities or payments to the Fund and sustainability-related risks.
 - The value of equities and equity-related securities can be affected by daily stock market movements. Other influential factors include political, economic news, company earnings and significant corporate events.
 - The Fund seeks to exclude companies engaging in certain activities inconsistent with ESG criteria. Such ESG screening may reduce the potential investment universe and this may adversely affect the value of the Fund's investments compared to a fund without such screening.
- ▶ Particular risks not adequately captured by the risk indicator include:
 - Counterparty Risk: The insolvency of any institutions providing services such as safekeeping of assets or acting as counterparty to derivatives or other instruments, may expose the Fund to financial loss.
 - Liquidity Risk: Lower liquidity means there are insufficient buyers or sellers to allow the Fund to sell or buy investments readily.
 - Tax treatment of Fund: The tax treatment of this fund structure is so far untested which could lead to adverse tax consequences for the investor. Changes to the tax status of the Fund could lead to taxation being due.

Charges

The charges are used to pay the costs of running the Fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

The entry and exit charges shown are maximum figures. In some cases you might pay less. Please refer to your financial advisor or the distributor for the actual entry and exit charges.

*Subject to a charge of up to 2% paid into the Fund where the Manager suspects excessive trading by an investor.

The ongoing charges figure shown here is an estimate of the annualised charges. An estimate is being used because the Fund (or unit class) was newly launched or it has been launched within the reported period. The Fund's annual report for each financial year will include detail on the exact charges made.

** To the extent the Fund undertakes securities lending to reduce costs, the Fund will receive 62.5% of the associated revenue generated and the remaining 37.5% will be received by BlackRock as the securities lending agent. As securities lending revenue sharing does not increase the costs of running the Fund, this has been excluded from the ongoing charges.
