

Laddered Municipal Fixed Income 1-5 Year

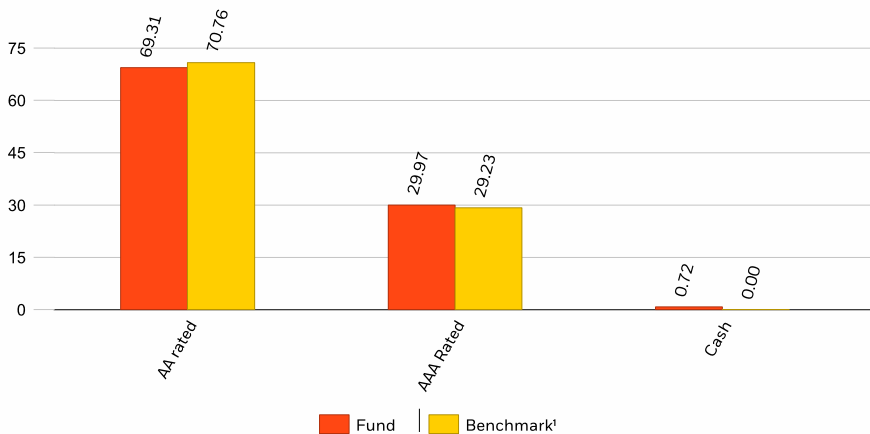
INVESTMENT STRATEGY

This investment strategy seeks to provide tax-exempt income by investing primarily in investment grade municipal securities that are laddered across consecutive maturities. Upon its maturity, a bond generally will be replaced with a bond having the longest maturity in the strategy's range. It also may invest in mutual funds and other pooled investment vehicles, which may pay fees and expenses to Blackrock that are in addition to the fees payable to BlackRock for managing the account. An investor selecting this strategy may risk some loss of principal. The principal risks of the strategy are credit risk, liquidity risk, counterparty risk. Credit quality ratings on underlying securities of the holdings within the portfolio are received from S&P, Moody's and Fitch and converted to the equivalent S&P major rating category. This breakdown is provided by BlackRock and takes the median rating of the three agencies when all three agencies rate a security, the lower of the two ratings if only two agencies rate a security, and one rating if that is all that is provided. Unrated securities do not necessarily indicate low quality. Below investment-grade is represented by a rating of BB and below. Ratings and portfolio credit quality may change over time.
